The Shine Zambia Reading Academy, established in 2007, teaches literacy to the most disadvantaged children from the shanty town of Kalikiliki on the outskirts of Lusaka. Its aim is to empower children through education to work their way out of powerty.

2018/2019 will be the second academic year we have paid the annual salary of a teacher and a cook.

In 2019 we have also paid for a librarian and some class-room furniture.

For some children this will be the only meal of the day. At least twice a week meals are of the local staple 'nshima', with beans and vegetables, and soya porridge on the other days.
