



## HOLMEWOOD HOUSE SCHOOL

### **Nursery Fees 2026/27**

Children may attend Holmewood House Nursery from the term in which they turn three years old.

The Nursery offers flexible childcare with term-time, all-year-round (50 weeks per year), and ad-hoc sessions available, subject to availability. The Nursery is open Monday to Friday from 7.30am to 6.00pm and closes during Christmas, Bank Holidays and School INSET days.

The following fees apply from 1 September 2026.

For those families preferring to attend term-time only, provision operates for 33 weeks per academic year. The examples below are based on an 11-week term. As school terms are not always split evenly, invoice values may vary slightly between terms.

\*Holmewood House offers the Universal Free Entitlement (FE) for term-time sessions only.

FE is Government-funded childcare available to all eligible three and four-year-olds and provides up to 15 funded hours per week. Funding may be claimed from the term following a child's third birthday up until and including the term a child turns five.

Eligible children attending term-time sessions may claim up to 495 funded hours per academic year. At Holmewood House, FE is applied as one funded three-hour block per day between 8.00am and 11.00am, up to a maximum of 15 funded hours per week.
